I would like to introduce myself as your new Director of Golf. Previous to my arrival in Ormond Beach I was the Head Professional at Tupelo Country Club in Tupelo, Mississippi. I have also had a few other stops along my path to Plantation Bay.

I started at the Polo Club in Boca Raton, and then moved to the Ledges in Huntsville, Alabama. While I was in Huntsville I met Mark Blackburn. Mark is a Golf Digest Top 100 Golf Instructor. As a young professional, with a passion for teaching, I was eager to learn from someone who was respected and knowledgeable as Mark. I love to work with golfers of all skill levels. I currently utilize Trackman, a Doppler Radar that tracks the ball and the club. Think of Trackman as an MRI machine for your golf swing!

I also use high speed video that gets sent right back to your phone so you can review past lessons. I'd love to show you how you can hit it farther and make the ball stop slicing, and Trackman is the tool to help us do it.

I am also into taking a holistic approach to golf. All of us have our physical ailments, even PGA Tour players. Those issues will affect the way we swing. I like to start out all of my new clients with a short functional movement screen. A short screen lets me know what you can, or can't do. My goal is to have you playing better golf pain free so you can play more golf!

## TURF TALK

Hello to everyone from the golf course maintenance staff! We all hope everyone is enjoying the newly renovated North / South nines. It was a long hot summer. The cool weather is finally here and with it we need to be extra careful how we drive our carts. We have been working with the crew on better driving practices to help protect weak areas that are still maturing. The grass has slowed down so we all need to be extra careful how we drive. Please everyone be conscious as to where you drive. Please avoid wet or thin areas and try to stay away from high traffic areas. We will be constantly putting up ropes and moving them to re-direct traffic. It will take some time for the course to mature and smooth out.

The greens and tees have recently been seeded at Prestwick and by the time you receive this newsletter should be grown in to provide a better putting surface. We have been steadily working on the course clean-up since the hurricane. This should take several more weeks to be finished. We are also going to add some drainage to some of the wet areas on Mondays when the course is closed. The Beautification / Landscaping is going to be an ongoing process and we will continue working on this as well.

## HOLING THE DREADED THREE-FOOTER

The match has come down to the final hole and all that remains is for you to make a three-foot putt to win. Oh my! Chances are you have been in this situation at one point or another throughout your golfing career.

But fear not! Here are three easy steps that you can apply next time you're in that situation:

- 1.) Make sure your putter face is square to your target. That means that the heel and the toe of the putter are in a direct line of one another. An easy way to make this happen is to allow the bottom of the putter to sit flush to the ground, where neither toe nor heel faces too much up or down.
- 2.) Pick a spot (piece of grass, discoloration, or anything that stands out) on your intended starting line and match the center of your clubface to that mark. The spot is where you want your ball to start rolling.
- 3.) There are only two possible outcomes: Make/Miss. Don't fret over the outcome of the putt! Take a deep breath, trust your read and line and make a smooth, accelerating stroke.

I hope these little pointers will help you knock down many three-footers in your future!

Relish the opportunity to close out the match! It is fun!

Happy New Year – 2017 – It is crazy to think we are embarking on our ten year anniversary of the Fitness Center. Join us at the start of the New Year in our fitness challenge. It is a great way to keep you motivated, and it will help to continue those good exercise habits throughout the New Year....

**Water** - once again let's talk about some benefits - these tips are from a cardiologist at Mayo Clinic.

Heart attacks maybe triggered by dehydration!! Drinking one glass of water before bed can prevent stroke or heart attack.

When is the correct time to drink water? Drinking water at certain time maximizes its effectiveness on the body. Two glasses of water after waking up - helps activate internal organs.

1 glass of water 30 minutes before a meal helps digestion!  
1 glass of water before taking a bath helps lower blood pressure. Water before bed also helps prevent night time leg cramps!! Ever woken up with that horrible Charlie Horse!!! Ouch!

Here are some of the healthy eating tips for the New Year.... California prune, yogurt and finding a balance!!

Research suggests that 5-6 prunes per day may help prevent bone loss in post menopausal women.

One serving 4-5 prunes, 100 calories, an excellent source of vitamin K - no added sugar and contains vitamins, minerals, potassium, copper, and boron which all may have bone protective effects.

Yogurt - One serving of yogurt every day provides in many cases the calcium, vitamin D and high quality protein that helps promote muscle and bone strength. Frequent yogurt consumption as part of a healthy diet pattern is associated with less weight gain over time. It is also associated with healthy levels of systolic blood pressure.

Small substitutions each day add up. Try making 2-3 healthier swaps each day to incorporate more fruits, vegetables, low fat dairy and whole grains.

- swap chips and dip for hummus and veggies
- swap white rice for brown - higher in fiber content
- swap a soda for sparkling water - a calorie-free, bubbly beverage



Power up with protein – to fuel your day and feel satisfied longer, include a variety of protein sources across meals and snacks such as lean meat, dairy, nuts, seeds, and legumes

On busy nights – try pairing a frozen entrée that heats in minutes – leaving time to prepare a side dish of fruits, and vegetables.

have a much softer feel for more control, especially in cooler climates. Finally, it is a much quieter ball. Try it out. We do have them in stock in the Pro Shop.


The SPLIT-STEP is the foundation for footwork in Pickleball and one of the most important techniques for successful positioning. The split-step is simply a small hop you take while in the ready position that allows you to react and move explosively around the court in any direction. While you are doing the small hop, it is also very important to place your paddle in the ready position with legs bent slightly at the knees. In doubles, a lot of players have the misconception that they need to rush to the non-volley line in a quick sprint. But it is better to make your way by taking 2-3 split step stops before making it to the line. This allows you to be in the best position to react, adjust and hit the next ball. Incorporating this will improve your game greatly. Try it!






