CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE The specifics below are also outlined in Section II.

Appropriate clothing in the Clubhouse is to benefit the Membership. Please make sure you and your guests adhere to the Clubhouse attire policy.

- Jeans are permitted for breakfast or lunch service only; jeans are NOT permitted in the Clubhouse for dinner service, unless stated for specific member events.
- As a courtesy, men must remove hats in the dining area.
- Appropriate Country Club attire is always required in the Clubhouse (Collared shirts and Bermuda shorts or long pants.)
- Proper length shorts are required in the Clubhouse. (No shorter than 5" from top of the knee.)
- Collared shirts are required, tasteful non-collared dress shirts may be acceptable. Specifically excluded are collarless tee-shirts, shirts with large printing on the back or front.
- No sweat pants, warm-up suits, or swimwear are permitted in the Clubhouse. (Tennis cover up warm-up suits are permitted.)

GUEST PRIVILEGES

Members may invite guests to use the Club and its facilities in compliance with the Club Rules and Regulations as established by Owner and subject to payment of the applicable daily guest fees and charges established by Owner from time to time. The Member is responsible for all actions of his or her guests and shall reimburse, indemnify and hold the Club harmless for any and all damages, loss, cost, claim, injury, death, or liability sustained or incurred by the Club and relating to the actions or omissions of such guests.

All guests shall be deemed to have a temporary Membership for that day. Management reserves the right to limit the number of times a guest of a Member may be extended the guest rate in a calendar year.

- Plantation Bay Residents may only be a guest of a member one (1) time in a calendar year per amenity. Residents outside the Plantation Bay community may be a guest of a member no more than six (6) times in a calendar year. Guests are required to sign in each time they attend a function or play golf. Guests of Members may be extended guest privileges subject to applicable guest fees and rules and regulations established by Management. Guest privileges may be denied, withdrawn or revoked at any time for reasons considered sufficient by Management in his/her sole and absolute discretion.
- Guests will be entitled to use the facilities of the Club only in accordance with the privileges of the Membership of the sponsoring Member and with payment of any applicable fees.
- Guests may use the golf facilities as the guest of a Member, within the guidelines in the Membership Plan.
- The sponsoring Member must register a particular individual using the facilities of the Club as a guest with the Club.

TURFTALK

At this time the West Lake greens are about 95 percent covered with turf grass and bunkers are complete with new sand. We have started to mow and fertilize and looking forward to reopening west. This will then allow us to begin some of the cultural practices necessary to maintain the greens on the north and south. The most important practice being aerification. This will help us with the combatting any turf issues. We have also verticut the fairways which help us with scalping when we mow them and provide a better playing surface. We are also cleaning out around all the lakes on the west nine. All the cordgrasses have been cut back and will fill in with fresh new growth all over.

The Prestwick course is coming along fine. The course should be totally planted over the next few weeks (weather permitting). We have started to refurbish all the bunkers. All the sand and rocks are being removed and new sand is being added. We have made a few changes which I'm sure will make the course a better one. The most notable change being 14. You can now see the green from your drive and the landing area is much bigger. The hole is a much more player friendly one. The range has also been redone and is now bigger with a new practice bunker. Some of the tees have been made bigger and we have added several new ones.





Have you noticed a lot of players (pros included) playing 'back' these days? New, more powerful racquets and strings allow more spin and speed to be hit off the groundstrokes, essentially taking the advantage away from the net player. Well, if players are camping out forever at the baseline, the "drop shot" is the perfect answer. The forecourt or front of the court closest to the net becomes the open court. Here's how to hit it:

- Start with a continental (hold like a hammer) grip
- Always start with the racquet head up
- With almost no backswing, bunt the ball softly bringing your racquet head under the ball guiding it gently over the net.
- Think in terms of a collision. If your racquet wins the collision the ball goes too far. So let the ball win the collision for a soft touch and a winning drop shot!
- Try hitting this shot with a partner or take the ball machine and practice until you are comfortable enough to use it in a game. ~ Good Luck!


NEW TENNIS COMMITTEE FORMED

Summer is in full swing, and with the summer comes extreme temperatures and humidity. Please remember, proper hydration is critical in maintaining your workouts and regular routine. Just a few tips: do not wait until you are thirsty. The benchmark for good hydration is that you should not be thirsty at all if you are drinking enough over the course of a day. Also take into consideration your age, weight and activity level. As we age, we need more water because it is common to become less thirsty and because our kidneys cannot conserve the water we drink as well. Another rule of thumb is the color of your urine: it should be a light straw color. If it is darker, you need more water. During an activity, it is best to try to consume half a cup of water every 15 minutes, but also listen to your body, and do not chug to the point of upsetting your stomach. Be aware: the popular sports drinks have added or artificial sugars. Coconut water is an awesome natural sports drink alternative and contains a nice balance of electrolytes, sodium and potassium without the added sugars. Stay hydrated!

AGING IS A NEW STAGE OF OPPORTUNITY AND STRENGTH! Keep moving and stay healthy!

Some key rules to longevity:

- Consistent cardiovascular exercise. A good goal is 8000 steps a day.
- Resistance training at least 2X per week. Develop a "fall" prevention plan.
- Eat a heart-healthy diet.
- Develop a stress-management plan. Get optimal sleep.
- Keep alcohol consumption light to moderate, and no smoking!

It is well known that many unfavorable physical and psychological conditions that occur with aging can be prevented or delayed in healthy adults with regular physical activity. Physical activity in older adults plays a major role in the prevention or risk reduction of heart disease, hypertension, osteoporosis, obesity, type 2 diabetes and abnormal cholesterol. Following are some tips to improve your energy and your game. There are three parts of your body that will help you play your best:

YOUR EYES - The average pickleball point lasts about nine hits. Keeping your eyes in a state of "high focus" for those hits is key to playing better. The ability to track the ball both early and throughout each point will help you anticipate and trigger both movement and paddle preparation. When you are ready, you will react faster, move earlier to the ball, maintain your balance and hit better shots.

YOUR FEET - It is not necessary to keep bouncing on your toes throughout each point, but it is extremely helpful to slightly bend your knees so your weight is on the balls of your feet and not on your heels. You want to bend your knees just enough so that when you look down, your shoelaces are hidden by your knees. The more you move, the stronger and faster you will become.

YOUR HANDS - The grip on the paddle! Some extra firmness on block volleys is good to add more rebound speed, but in general, try to keep a relaxed grip whenever you are NOT hitting the ball and even a little more relaxed when you ARE hitting the ball. Holding the paddle with a more relaxed grip allows you to swing the paddle more quickly, producing more power. Faster hands mean you will handle shots more easily and be less intimidated by harder-hitting players.




