Hello Plantation Bay members,

As our high season, kicks off we will again start rolling out the events our members love. The first event I want to remind everyone of is the second annual Battle of the Bay. TURFTALK

We have recently aerified the greens on the north and south nines. This aerification will help with the recovery of the Fairy ring problem we have encountered. The aerification will open up the greens so the fungicides and water will penetrate into the greens instead of running off the surface. Some of the benefits of core aeration are:

- 1. The release of toxic gases from the soil
- 2. Improved wetting of dry or hydrophobic soils
- 3. Accelerated drying of persistent dry soils
- 4. Increased infiltration capacity, especially where surface compaction and or thatch limits infiltration
- 5. Stimulated root growth within the aerification holes
- 6. Increased shoot growth atop the aerification holes
- 7. Disruption of soil layers resulting from topdressing
- 8. Control of thatch, especially where soil cores are reincorporated or where topdressing follows coring
- 9. Improved turf grass response to fertilizers

In closing I would like to thank the members for the positive comments and would like to ask everyone to feel free to ask me any questions you have regarding the maintenance of the golf courses.

Wellness News



Summer is behind us and we are in the middle of fall. Remember, even with the cooler temperatures it is still important to stay hydrated. Make sure you drink plenty of water before, during and after your activities.

Let us Stand Up to Aging! G2S – Ground-to-Standing exercises. These exercises can help older exercisers preserve strength, improve agility and prevent hazardous falls. As we get older, getting up off the ground grows more difficult, muscle and bones weaken, coordination becomes less fluid and simple house hold chores become more challenging. G2S exercises can help to address these changes.

Aging has three fundamental markers — dynapenia (loss of muscle strength), sarcopenia (loss of muscle mass) and decreased lean body mass (loss of muscle, bone and connective tissue). These changes are what makes it more challenging for movement efficiently and effectively in three dimensions: direction, distance and depth. The benefits of doing G2S drills help improve performance in daily living skills, slows the impact of sarcopenia and dynapenia, increases bone and tissue density, improves balance and helps prevent falls. The exercises should be preformed daily and progress simple to more difficult. Here are the names of the exercises: Tall Kneeling Step to Stand, Crisscross Applesauce Spin, Supine Roll to Inchworm, Prone to Stand to Statue, and Sidelying Crossover to Forward Lunge. Pictures are Available @Wellness Center if you are interested.

A strong skeleton is as important as a healthy heart. Bone loss is also a normal part of aging. It is important for us to develop a plan to prevent unnecessary bone loss. Here are some bone basics: calcium, vitamin D and physical activity are critical to preserving and building bone mass, walking has limited effect on bone health, progressive resistance training helps maintain and improve bone mineral density, high impact activities help the most with bone growth, posture and balance training are essential to fall prevention and women over 50 have the highest risk of osteoporosis and fractures. Walking is often the top recommendation for osteoporosis, however, it does have limitations, but if combined with resistance training the benefits are much greater.

Where are your opponents located? If they are close to the kitchen and leaning forward this is a good time, if they are a few steps behind the kitchen – not the best opportunity.


Where is your location on the court? It is best to lob when you are close to the kitchen or just a few steps behind. Lobbing from the base line or behind can be iffy - this allows your opponent time to move into position to hit an aggressive smash. Also – do not lob from behind the baseline and when your partner is at the net – this makes your partner a perfect target!

Where are your opponents moving to? Are they moving or leaning forward? You could catch them by surprise by throwing up a lob. If they are moving back a few steps, you might end up getting your lob smashed right at your feet.

Which shoulder are you lobbing over? There is a chance your lob will be more successful if you can lob the ball over your opponents backhand shoulder.

Wind – Wind direction is an important factor when playing outdoors. Next time you are playing just give these W's some consideration. See how you do.


