# FRIENDLY REMINDER OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

# Dear Members,

In order to protect the integrity of your membership, it is important to be mindful of the Club's Guest Policies as it pertains to Golf, Fitness, Pool, Tennis, Pickleball, Bocce and Clubhouse Dining amenities. The policies listed below may also be found in your Membership Plan and Rule Regulations provided to members. Members must accompany their guest and register at the golf shop prior to scheduled tee time.

#### **Guest Policies:**

- Members and guests are required to register at the Golf Course clubhouse, fitness center front desk for use of Fitness, Tennis, Pickleball, Bocce and Spa Services & Pool use.
- Plantation Bay Non Members residents may only be the guest of a member one (1) time in a calendar year per amenity. Residents outside the Plantation Bay Community may be the guest of a member no more than six (6) times in a calendar year (Excluding immediate family members).
- Clubhouse & Fitness Members may only be a guest of a full golf member one (1) time in a calendar year. (Applicable guest fees apply)
- Sports Members may be the guest of a full golf member one (1) time during peak season and may be permitted to play ten (10) times during non-peak season. (Applicable guest fees apply)
- Practice Facilities are for the sole use of our Full Golf Members and their guest. All other classifications have access to the range ONLY in conjunction with their round of golf.

## **Clubhouse Attire:**

It is expected that Members will choose to dress in a fashion that benefits the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the Club setting. Specific dress requirements for varying dining times and events will be posted. It is also expected that members will advise their guest of Club Attire requirements. The specifics below are also outlined in Section II in the Rule and Regulations provided to Members.

- Jeans are permitted for breakfast or lunch service only. Jeans are NOT permitted in the clubhouse for dinner service, unless stated for specific member events. No cutoffs or torn jeans will be permitted at any time.
- As a courtesy, men must remove hats in the dining room.
- Appropriate Country Club attire is always required in the Clubhouse (collared shirts and Bermuda shorts or long pants).
- Both Proper length shorts and collared shirts are required. Specifically excluded are tee shirts and shirts with large printing on the back or front.
- No sweat pants, warm- up suits, or swimsuits are permitted in the clubhouse. (Tennis cover-up warm- up suits are permitted).

### **Golf Attire / Rules:**

- Player must register with the Golf Staff at least 15 minutes before commencing play to ensure preserving their standing tee time.
- Dress code for golf applies to the putting green, driving range, practice areas, pro shop and locker rooms as well as the golf course.
- Male golfers must wear appropriate golf attire, which may include golf slacks, Bermuda shorts, and shirts with collars. Mock turtlenecks are also acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. No cargo shorts are permitted.
- Female golfers must wear appropriate golf attire, which may include golf slacks, Bermuda shorts and golf skirts
- It is the member's responsibility to inform their guest of this policy prior to their visit.
- Privately owned golf carts must be electric battery powered, quiet in operation and tasteful
  in appearance. All carts must have the same body shape, size (including tires) and general
  color as the Plantation Bay fleet (light Beige). Four (4) seater cart and or carts with
  extensions are not permitted. All carts must be approved by the Planation Bay Director of
  Golf before gaining access to the golf course.
